## NCPDP VERSION D.Ø IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE

Claims for PACE, SPBP, CRDP and all plans administered by the Department of Aging are to continue to be submitted on NCPDP version 5.1 beyond January 1, 2012.

It is anticipated that in March 2012, PACE and all programs administered by the Department of Aging will transition to a new platform thereby permitting acceptance of NCPDP version D.Ø. When this transition occurs, claims submitted in either NCPDP version D.Ø **OR** 5.1 will be accepted. This <u>dual</u> acceptance will continue for approximately 2 weeks.

Upon finalization of the transition/ D.Ø implementation date, all providers and software vendors will be notified. The Department anticipates a minimum two (2) week advance notice.

Providers not yet certified by Magellan Health Services to submit claims using Version D.Ø are advised that specifications have been e-mailed to all PACE software providers and are available on the Department of Aging's website. Additionally, Provider Services will e-mail specifications upon request.

NOTE: Providers receiving their R/A via 835 FTP will continue to receive the 835-4010 version until the D.Ø implementation. Following the implementation of D.Ø, R/A's will be produced in both the 825-4010 and 835-5010 format.
