NEW PACE Legislation

Effective February 21, 2022, the PACENET eligibility income will be increased and the accumulation of the PACENET premium eliminated.

This change:

- increases PACENET eligible annual income.
 - For Single Person-- not less than \$14,500 and not more than \$33,500
 - For a Married Couple-- not less than \$17,700 and not more than \$41,500
- eliminates the accumulation of the PACENET premium and the accumulation of the Medicare Part D premium for the PACE Partner Plans.
 - Collection of <u>up to</u> 1-month premium + any applicable copay will occur at the pharmacy on the months medications are dispensed.
 - The amount paid by the cardholder <u>will not</u> exceed the cost of the medication.
 - If the amount paid by cardholder for the month is less than the 1-month premium, remaining premium <u>will not</u> be charged in a future month.
